In addition to the life, health, and safety issues at Meadow Bridge High School, the building's 2nd floor has been condemned since 2015.



The front entrances to both Meadow Bridge High School and Elementary School do not have separate, secure visitor entry points.



This is the coal fired boiler used to heat the High School facility. The custodial staff must fill the hoppers from the coal bin every 2 hours in order to keep the school at a reasonable temperature during cold weather.



The “New Gym” was constructed in 1987 and sits adjacent to the existing High School. The new high school and elementary school facilities will be built around this gym in a phased construction plan.
