## SBA Needs Project Evaluation Summary

### **Project Request:**

Grant County requests up to \$7,025,000 in SBA funding for county-wide energy management upgrades. These funds will be used in partnership with a local contribution of \$2,835,000 for a total project cost of \$9,860,000.

### **Project Status:**

Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 9/26/18 with Doug Lambert, Superintendent of Grant County Schools and David Roach, Ben Ashley, Angie Bradley, and Dana Womack of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Grant County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by CMTA Engineers.
- The \$2,835,000 in local funds as proposed in this project are part of a 15-year term leasepurchase, which, if funded, will be secured by using the \$195,000 in projected annual savings as collateral.

#### **Project Comments by the SBA Staff:**

- The majority of the proposed work is at Union Educational Complex. Fifty-year-old boilers will be replaced with an efficient geothermal HVAC system. A roof replacement, lighting upgrades and a new sewage treatment plant are also proposed at this facility.
- At Petersburg High School, new rooftop cooling units are proposed over the gymnasium area. The school's main air handler will be replaced.
- District-wide improvements, as proposed by the county, include efficient lighting and plumbing fixture upgrades and a new web-based direct digital control system.
- The county also proposes to add a half megawatt of photovoltaic solar panels to Petersburg Elementary School to further offset electrical utility costs.
