### **Project Status:**

Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 10/9/19 with Troy Ravenscroft, Superintendent, and Ken Baker, Facilities Director of Mineral County Schools and Mike Hall of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Mineral County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by Williamson Shriver Architects.
- Mineral County submitted a project similar to this for consideration in the 2019 Needs funding cycle. After the project was not funded, the county elected to reduce the overall scope by removing the energy management performance contract portion of the 2019 request.

#### **Project Comments by the SBA Staff:**

- The county proposes to replace the entire roofing systems at both Keyser and Frankfort Middle Schools. This project will address water infiltration issues caused by the failing roof system. Leaks during rain showers regularly disrupt classes throughout both buildings and have led to potential mold growth in several areas. The county has extended the life of this roofing system through regular preventative maintenance; however, these efforts have limited effectiveness at this time.
- The existing HVAC system at Keyser Middle has well exceeded its life expectancy. The original
  systems from 1976 are difficult to maintain and repair. The system at Frankfort Middle, while
  significantly newer, is still more than 20 years old, and the central chiller is near failure. Indoor
  air quality deficiencies have been cited by the WVDE Office of School Facilities and replacement
  is recommended.
- While Keyser Middle School appears to be in the 100-year flood plain, the county administrators say the facility has not flooded since opening in 1976. However, the county carries an active flood insurance policy.
