Pleasants County requests up to \$731,863 in SBA funding for new, larger freezers and refrigerators for the kitchen area at both Pleasants County Middle School and St. Marys Elementary School. In addition, this project also includes electrical and lighting upgrades at Pleasants County Middle School. These funds will be used in partnership with a local contribution of \$129,152 for a total project cost of \$861,015.

Project Status:

Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 10/13/2019 with Mike Wells, Superintendent, Rex Cox, Director of Facilities of Pleasants County Schools, Bill Ratcliffe of Thrasher Architecture and Engineering, and Joyce VanGilder of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Pleasants County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by Thrasher Architecture and Engineering.

Project Comments by the SBA Staff:

- In kitchen area at Pleasants County Middle School, the only access point to the freezer is through the cooler. This is an inadequate situation and limits the space available for storage within both units. Space is available for expansion within an underutilized storage area within the existing footprint of the kitchen.
- Previous HVAC renovations at St. Marys Elementary School have created extra space that is now
 open for a kitchen expansion. The existing freezer and cooler are undersized and have exceeded
 their life expectancies.
- Pleasants County Middle School was originally constructed with an open classroom concept. Over the years, the county has attempted to rearrange this facility into a more traditional classroom layout. However, this has resulted in inadequate lighting and HVAC operation in some spaces. The existing lighting is a non-traditional size (4'x4') which does not allow for simple replacement. This project proposes to add new lighting and ceilings throughout the facility.
