Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 9/28/23 with Michael Fitzwater and Joe Paxton of Calhoun County Schools, and Tommy Young of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Calhoun County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by ZMM Architects and Engineers.

Project Comments by the SBA Staff:

- Calhoun County MS/HS was constructed in 1998 with the use of SBA funds. This is one of several SBA-funded facilities from this timeframe that have requested component or system replacements. The existing chiller and boilers are original to the facility and have extended beyond their life expectancy, consistently failing. During the seasons of operation, the current equipment performs less efficiently, which leads to an inadequate learning environment. In addition, the county expends a greater amount of money on maintenance and energy costs due to this inefficiency.
- The county proposes to replace the chiller, boilers, and install a Dedicated Outdoor Air System (DOAS) at the existing facility. This would allow the county to operate the school more efficiently and would permit maintenance to shift from reactionary to preventative. Additionally, the county will be able to save money on energy bills and improve the efficiency of their HVAC system.
