Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 10/5/23 with Dan Enich, Superintendent of Hancock County Schools, and Tommy Young of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Hancock County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by McKinley Architects and Engineers.

Project Comments by the SBA Staff:

- Oak Glen Middle School was constructed in 2005 with SBA funding. A 10,000 square foot area of the facility is experiencing heaving floor slabs due to the expansion of pyritic matter found in the material used for the fill under the facility. The movement of the soil is creating unleveled hallways and instructional spaces, along with affecting the opening and closing of doors creating school safety concerns. In addition, the structural integrity of the load bearing walls could also be compromised if not addressed soon.
- Hancock County proposes to remove the interior walls, concrete floor slabs, and sub-grade
 material in the affected areas. New engineered fill material will be installed along with new
 concrete floor slabs. In addition, new exterior walls will be constructed, and door openings
 repaired as needed.
