- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 10/2/24 with Jerry Cremeans, Director of Facilities of Lincoln County Schools, along with Mark Miller of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Lincoln County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by Williamson Shriver Architects.

Project Comments by the SBA Staff:

- Lincoln County High School has two chillers which serve the 217,000 square foot building, with one original to the facility, which has reached the end of its lifespan. The county's maintenance staff works tirelessly to keep this chiller functioning. The other chiller was previously replaced. Additionally, the school was designed prior to the implementation of safe school entrances, and thus lacks a controlled entry point for visitors.
- Lincoln County proposes to replace the aging chiller at Lincoln County High School, as well as construct a safe school entrance within the existing main entrance of the building.
