Project Status:

Listed below are projected activities that have been completed to date.

- After reviewing the submitted documents and information, an on-site review was performed on 10/15/24 with Christie Willis, Superintendent, Martin Best, Director of Facilities, and Brett Ubbens of Wood County Schools, along with Patrick Elliott of the SBA Staff.
- On behalf of Wood County Schools, a project budget and conceptual plan was established by McKinley Architecture and Engineers.

Project Comments by the SBA Staff:

- Greenmont Elementary School is seated in a residential area, and the school's main entrance is fronted by a 2-way street. Residential on-street parking narrows this to 1 ½ lanes. During drop off/pick up, parents stop their vehicles on the street in the front of the school, causing major congestion/backups each morning and afternoon.
- Without a dedicated bus loop, buses currently must turn around at the back of the school in the staff parking lot. There have reportedly been three cars hit by buses while turning.
- This project proposes a new bus loop/drop-off lane, and additional parking spaces (including handicapped accessible spaces) directly in front of the school. In addition, new safety features such as speed bumps, traffic signs, ADA compliant pedestrian walkways, and enhanced lighting will be included.
