#### **CEFP AMENDMENTS**

Kanawha County Board of Education CEFP Amendment - (Action) - ATTACHMENT E

The Kanawha County Board of Education requested approval to revise their 2020-2030 CEFP to include a change in their project priority list and the following closures and consolidations. 1) Marmet Elementary School is proposed for closure and consolidation into the existing Chesapeake Elementary School. 2) Grandview Elementary School is proposed for closure and consolidation into Edgewood Elementary School and Mary C. Snow West Side Elementary School. 3) George C. Weimer Elementary School is proposed for closure and consolidation into Alban Elementary School and Bridgeview Elementary School. These Kanawha County Board of Education and are proposed to occur at the end of the 2023-2024 school year.

Kanawha County Board of Education has complied with the SBA CEFP Amendment Process, and as such, Executive Director Neptune respectfully recommended approval of this amendment.
